Concordia University requires an essay with the College Composition Modular test, and the essay portion is given here on campus. * Students who have taken or plan to take ENG120 or Freshman College Composition CLEP cannot receive credit for this exam.
** Three-hour exam. Students must pass both multiple-choice and essay to receive credit. Students who have taken the English Composition CLEP cannot receive credit for this exam. Does NOT meet Teacher Education requirement for EDU336. Cannot be taken in addition to EDU336.
^ Students who have taken Principles of Accounting are not eligible for credit for this exam.

NOTE: CLEP credit is not granted when it duplicates credit previously earned.
